

Leadership Philosophy Infographic

This assignment is designed to allow you to visually communicate your leadership philosophy through an infographic (if you are unfamiliar with what infographics are or why they are used, [clicking here](#) will provide you with more information as well as example infographics). Your infographic should focus on elements and characteristics of a specific career field or discipline that you are interested in working in (e.g., athletic trainer, physical therapist, nurse, sport psychology consultant, etc.).

You can be as creative as you would like with your infographic, using images, text, charts, etc. but your infographic needs to include the following information:

- Explicit leadership position or field of work (e.g., nursing, teacher, athletic trainer, physical therapy)
- How you will set goals for those you are leading (remember this could be other employees, patients, team members, etc.)
 - How will you motivate them to achieve these goals?
 - How will you measure their progress towards achieving their goals?
- How will you use your authority to make decisions?
 - What leadership style will you have (e.g., democratic, consultative, etc.)?
- How will you work with others?
- Incorporate at least one leadership theory that has support in the field of sport and exercise psychology (hint: do not use approaches for this, such as trait or behavioral, but theories like we discussed in the lecture) and build your leadership philosophy with theory at its core. Be sure to be explicit with the theory you are using
